LANSTON GAVE THE NAME "MONOTYPE" TO THIS MACHINE. HIS EFFORTS TO PERFECT THE ORIGINAL MACHINE CONVINCED HIM OF ITS IMPRACTICABILITY AS A TYPE MAKER, AND HE STARTED TO WORK OUT THE DETAILS OF A MACHINE FOR CASTING HIS TYPE FROM \$1234567890
